Release of Funds

The <u>City of Tetonia</u> certifies to the Idaho Department of Commerce that <u>Brent Schindler</u> in his official capacity as <u>Mayor</u> consents to accept the jurisdiction of the federal courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. The Idaho Department of Commerce's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities, and allows for the City to use ICDBG funds.

Objections to State Release of Funds

The Idaho Department of Commerce will accept objections to its release of funds and the City's certification for a period of sixteen (16) days following the anticipated submission date or its receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases:

- a. The certification was not executed by the certifying officer.
- The City has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58;
- c. The City has committed funds or incurred costs not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of the release of funds by the Idaho Department of Commerce.
- d. Another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality.

Statement of Purpose and Need for the Proposal: [40 CFR 1508.9(b)] This project will install prefabricated restrooms in the city park to replace the park's old restrooms which will be closed and used for storage. The aged and cracking basketball court will be replaced with new concrete and surfaces.

Description of the Proposal: Include all contemplated actions, which logically are either geographically or functionally a composite part of the project, regardless of the source of funding [24 CFR 58.32, 40 CFR 1508.25]. Improvements to existing basketball court and installation of prefabricated restrooms, including installation of sewer and water lines to the new restroom facility.

Existing Conditions and Trends: Describe the existing conditions of the project area and its surroundings, and trends likely to continue in the absence of the project [24CFR 58.40(a)]. The City Park is a hub of recreational activities and community gathering for city residents, highly utilized for activities, events and recreation. A public survey completed in 2024 indicated the residents thought the installation of a new restroom facility and improvements to the basketball/sports court were high priorities for the community. The current restroom facility would become a storage facility for the city.
