## **Action Items**

Forsgren on road planning- Action Aaron from Forsgrens reviewed the road meeting he had with Kevin Harris, Jay and Gloria. It was reminded that the City has a grant of \$100,000. Cost proposals were presented for 3 different options of different road repairs and material options were presented to the City Council. Options were also discussed about applying for another LTHAC grant for in 2 years to go over mag with a double chip seal. Council will discuss and let Aaron know the final decision. No action made at this time.

John Pell road presentation- Action John addressed Jorgensen street and his property line and where the road over rides his property. He talked about his concern about people driving into his property thinking it's the roadway. Mayor Hoopes agreed to get road measured and put another pin on the east side of the road to help mark distance. Mayor Hoopes said that Jay will need to go out within the next month and measure and mark the road for definition. Other issues is that the grating being done by City is hitting his apron from outside his garage. John understand that there are processes to go through but he wants this problem brought to light. No action needed.

Seniors West of the Tetons- Action No show,

Scott Kauf event presentation – Action Scot Kauf suggested that the City make an ordinance for outdoor music. Gloria told Scot that the options were offered to him and that he was also told before and the City as working on another options. Scott is wanting to have weekly ongoing music outside for his clientele. Clarification was made of what is considered a special event and what is considered a nuisance. No action needed.
