

Dear Tetonia friends,

We have greatly enjoyed our beautiful summer and now we move into our cooler Fall season. As usual, we anticipate this month will be a beautiful time of transition as we move into our Fall season.

Remember that school is in session. Give safe space to our school buses and our young residents as they travel to and from school. Slow down for our treasured children, pets and wild animals who are out and about on our roads.

Campaign season is approaching! Please familiarize yourself with the candidates and the positions that will be on our ballot. We will see that the Local Option Tax is again on our ballot. This is an opportunity to place a small tax on goods and services purchased within Tetonia. This is an attempt to get funds from the travelers who pass through Tetonia and use our services. It is a tax similar to the Local Option Tax in Driggs and Victor; it spreads the tax revenue to those who use our services; not just our residents. In consideration of expansion plans in Tetonia, we are considering the establishment of an Urban Development Zone. This is an oft-used system of helping expanding towns fund the infrastructure needs for development. This would be a special tax zone for areas to be annexed into the town. This would not add any additional tax to the currently existing town residents. This mechanism allows the funding of the new infrastructure to be applied against the new areas of annexation and development. Let me know if you want additional information on this funding mechanism.

Please help the integrity of our town's sewer system by NOT flushing things that should not be flushed into our system. The wipes (which may be advertised as flushable) should not be flushed into our sewer system. This clogs our system which is problematic for the integrity of our system.
